1. Presenters must use a concise slide deck (maximum of 10–12 slides). The presentation should focus on the technical soundness of the proposal rather than creative design. The following structure is recommended:

For Basic/Action Research:

Slide No.	Content/Component	Key Focus
1	Title Slide	Research Title, Name of Proponent(s), and School/Station
2-3	Introduction/ Context & Rationale	The "Why" behind the study; the specific problem being addressed
4	Conceptual Framework/ Research Paradigm	What is being studied and how concepts connect: identifies variables, constructs, and hypothesized relationships
5	Research Questions	Clear, specific, and measurable questions the study aims to answer
6	Proposed Intervention	(For Action Research) The specific strategy or program to be tested
7	Methodology: Design	Research Design (e.g. Descriptive, Quasi-experimental, etc.)
8	Methodology: Participants	Sampling method and target respondents.
9	Methodology: Data Collection	Instruments to be used (e.g. pre-test, survey, interview)
10	Methodology: Data Analysis	Statistical tools or qualitative themes to be employed
11	Work Plan & Timetable	Gantt chart of activities for the duration of the study (just show it; no need to explain further)
12	Cost Estimates	Itemized budget aligned with BERF/Local fund guidelines (just show it; no need to explain further)

2. A 10-minute research presentation shall be given to research presenter/s.
3. Another 10 minutes shall be given 10 minutes o research presenter/s to answer the questions from the research panelists.
4. Schools Division Research Committee Members including the Technical Working Group and Division Statisticians shall serve as panelists/board of judges.
5. All presenters are expected to dress in appropriate business/professional attire (or the prescribed DepEd uniform).
